KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

On Friday, May 3rd, Lucerne Elementary held a registration clinic for all fall 2019 newly entering Kindergarten children who live within the Lucerne Elementary School District. If you missed the registration day, please come into the school office and pick up a packet for registration.

ATTENTION K AND 1ST GRADE PARENTS

Health Physical:

Students who will be in the 1st grade for the 2019/2020 school year must receive a physical **before** attending 1st grade as required by the state of California.

Oral (Dental) Assessment:

No later than May 31 of the relevant school year, the parent/guardian of a kindergarten student shall certify that the student has received an oral health assessment. The oral health assessment must be performed by a licensed dentist or other authorized dental health professional no earlier than 12 months prior to the date of the student's initial enrollment

TDAP IMMUNIZATION

All students entering, advancing or transferring into 7th grade will need proof of an adolescent whooping cough booster immunization (called "Tdap") for school in the fall. Pertussis is a very contagious respiratory disease that can be severe and last for months.

LIBRARY NEWS
