Dear Lucerne Elementary Families,

We have made a very difficult decision to dismiss students from attending school 3/16-4/10. We understand that this will be a hardship on our families and their students, but we also have a responsibility to keep our students and staff safe. At this time the threat of COVID-19 spread is a real concern and as an institution we need to make a comprehensive plan to understand and address this threat.

The school board, teachers, and staff will be working to provide services to all of our students. It is our hope that we can create a plan that provides students with a high quality education, food services, and special education support during this time. Because information about COVID-19 and how to address the spread of the virus is constantly being reevaluated our plan will also be adaptive to the current Public Health Code directives.

Educational Student Work Resources

Teachers will be providing packets of age appropriate educational materials, as well as online resources, to keep students engaged in learning. The packets will be available for pick-up on Wednesday, March 18th from 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19th from 8:00 a.m.-10:00a.m, and Friday, March 20th from 8:00a.m-10:00a.m. Special pick up times for packets can also be arranged through the office. Teachers will be available through e-mail to help assist their students with the completion of these student work resource packets.

Food Service

Food service will be available for students who need it. Prepared meals will be distributed once a day at bus stops to any school aged child. The schedule for delivery will be posted on the school website.

Students with an Individualized Education Plan

For students that have a current IEP our resource teacher will be sending student work resources to families that support their IEP goals. We are working with our speech and language pathologist as well as our occupational therapist to develop a plan for supporting students during the closure. We will provide information about these services once a plan is in place.

Best Practices for Students and Families during this Time

We encourage all households to implement some procedures that help to mitigate the spread of all contagions. Wash hands frequently with soap for at least 20 seconds. Cover mouth when coughing or sneezing with a tissue or the inside of your arm. Frequently sanitize surfaces and practice social distancing with all people that do not live in your home. Limit travel and keep students at home rather than allowing them to go out in to the community.

Recursos de trabajo de estudiantes educativos

Los maestros estaran disponibles por correo electronico para ayudar a un estudiante a completar los paquetes de recursos de trabajo estudiantiles.

Servicios de la comida

Servicio de la comida estara disponible para los estudiantes que lo necesiten. Comidas preparadas seran distribuido una vez al dia en las paradas de autobuses a cualquier nino/nina en edad escolar. Este horario sera publicado en la pagina Web de la escuela.

Estudiantes con planes educativos individuales (IEP)

Para los estudiantes que tienen actual IEP nuestro maestro de recurso enviara recursos de trabajo estudiantiles a familias que apoyan sus objetivos de IEP. Estamos trabajando con nuestro patologo de lenguaje ademas nuestro terapeuta ocupacional para desarrollar un plan que apoyan a los estudiantes durante este cierre escolar. Proporcionaremos informacion sobre estos servicios tan pronto como un plan este listo.

Buenas Practicas para los estudiantes y familias durante este tiempo

Animamos a todos log hogares a aplicar algunos procedimientos que ayudan a mitigar la propagacion de todo el contagio. Lavese los manos con frecuencia con jabon durante al menos 20 segundos. Tapate la boca cuando toses o estornudar con un pañuelo o el interior de tu brazo. Con frecuencia, desinfecta superficies y practica distanciamiento social con todas las personals que no viven en tu casa. Limitar el viage y mantener a los estudiantes en casa en lugar de permitirles salir en la comunidad.
