### **Purpose:**

The purpose of this public hearing is to provide an opportunity for parents, teachers, and members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders to directly address the board regarding the sufficiency or insufficiency of instructional materials. Parents, teachers, members of the community interested in the affairs of the school district, and bargaining unit leaders, are encouraged to participate in this hearing.

Subsequent to the public hearing, under Curriculum and Instruction, the Board will make a determination, through a resolution, as to whether each pupil in each school in the district has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials, or both, that are aligned to the content standards adopted pursuant to Education Code Section 60605 in each of the following subjects, in each of the following subjects, as appropriate, that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum framework adopted by the state board:

- (i) Mathematics.
- (ii) Science.
- (iii) History-social science.
- (iv) English/Language Arts, including the English language development component of an adopted program.

As part of the hearing required pursuant to this section, the Board will also make written determinations as to whether each pupil enrolled in a foreign language or health course has sufficient textbooks or instructional materials that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks adopted by the state board for those subjects, and the availability of laboratory science equipment as applicable to science laboratory courses offered in grades 9 to 12, inclusive.
