School Choice:

What right does a parent have to request a transfer to a school that is not in PI?

An LEA must offer all students enrolled in Title I schools (that is, schools that operate programs funded under Title I, Part A of the ESEA) that have been identified for school improvement, corrective action, or restructuring the opportunity to transfer to another public school in the LEA that is not so identified.

All of our neighboring districts as well as many districts outside of the county are also in PI. Most school districts in Lake County already support the concept of Open Enrollment, as they believe in the participation of parents in their students' educational choices and have given parents the opportunity to enroll their children in other districts for many years. Within the No Child Left Behind law, parents of students attending a Title I PI school may send their child to a non-PI school in the district and receive transportation to a designated district school at district expense. However, Lucerne Elementary School District has only one elementary school.
